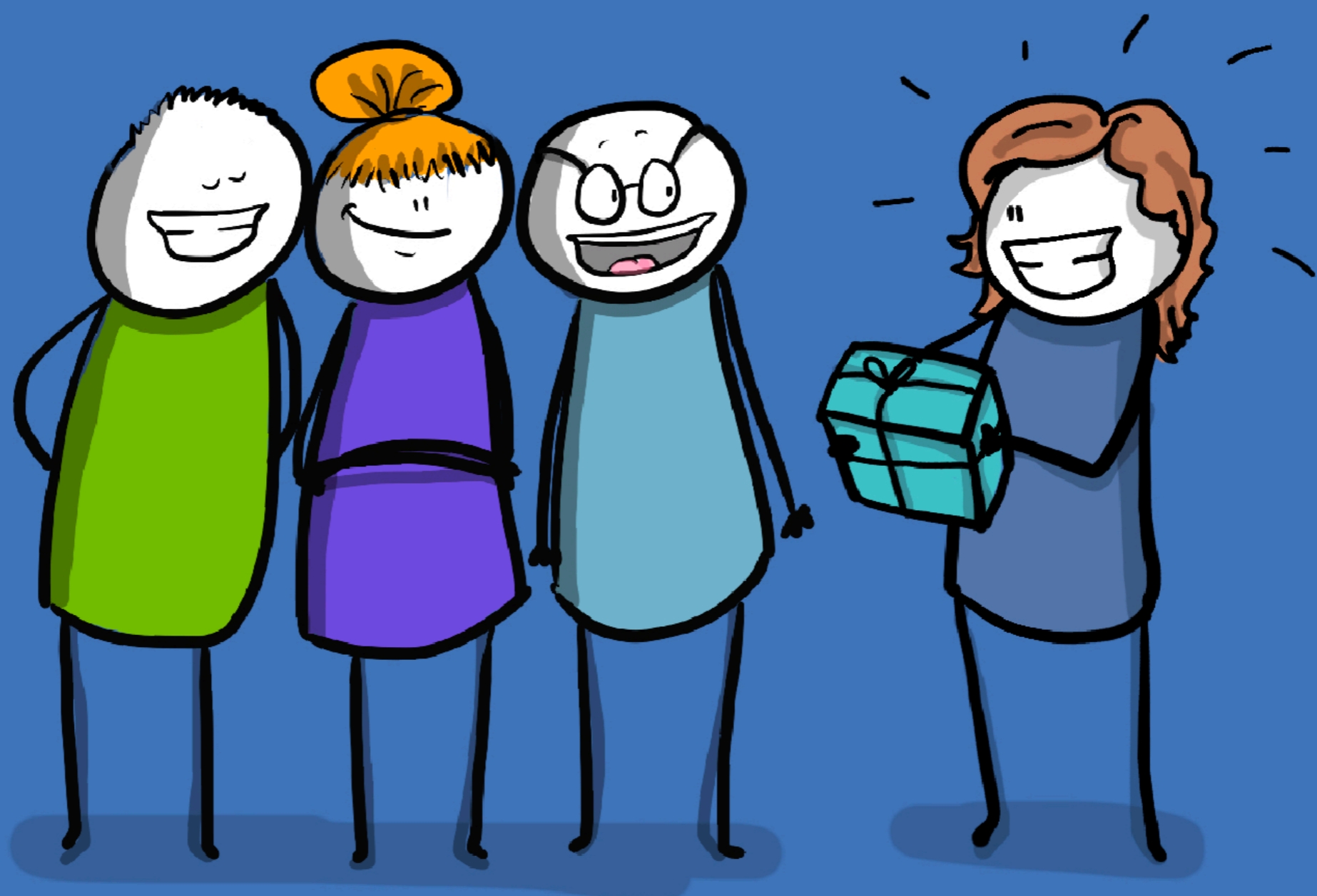

We're not here to do better Scrum, we're here to make a difference for our customers and capture that in business value.



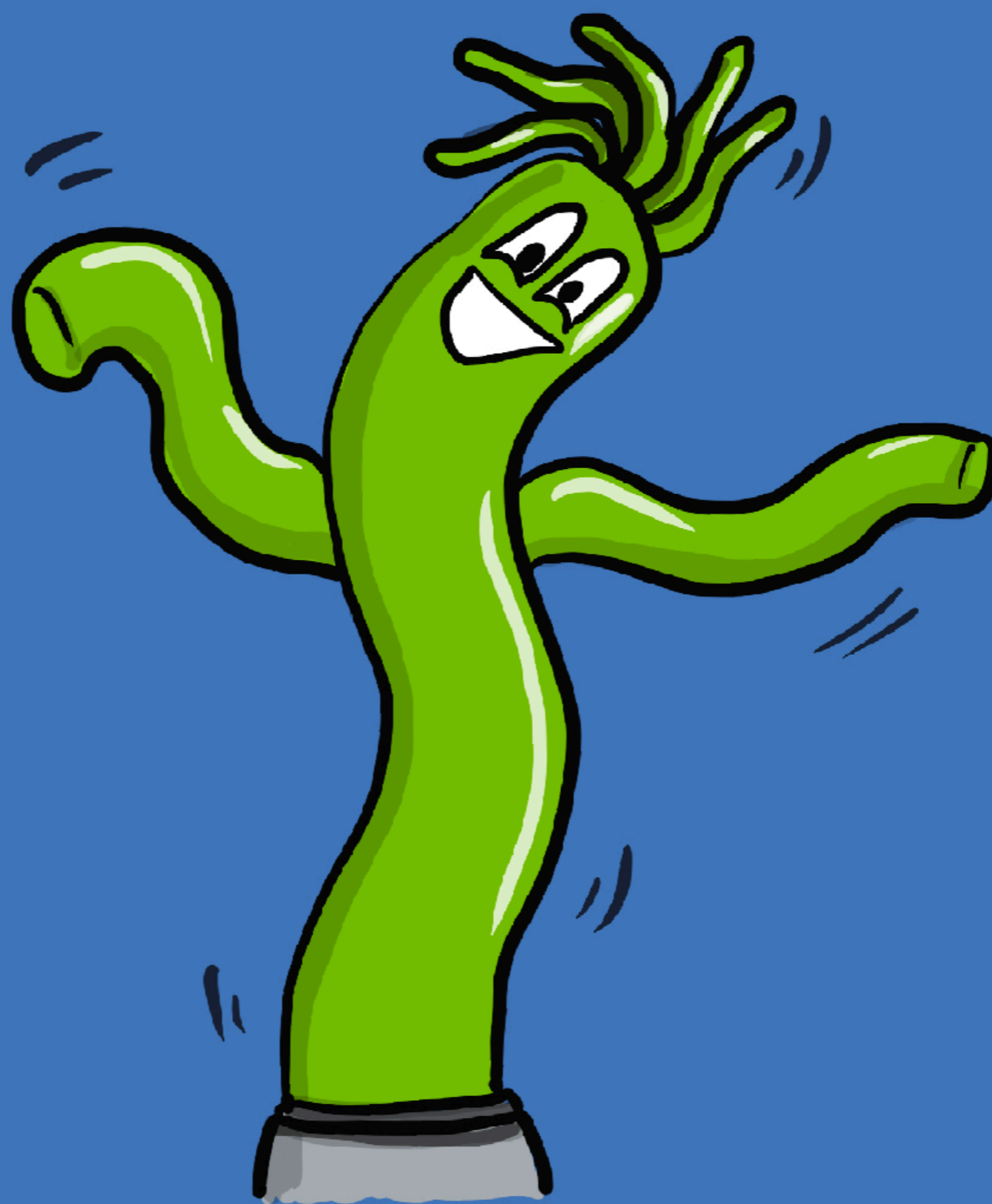

SCRUM can only succeed when we discover better ways of working

Product Owners don't care about following Scrum by the letter. Are we discovering better ways of working on top of the Scrum framework? Scrum is purposefully incomplete which means we have to enrich it. Perfectly incomplete, at best, can only be incomplete.

Let's worry less about better Scrum and more about discovering better ways of delivering value.

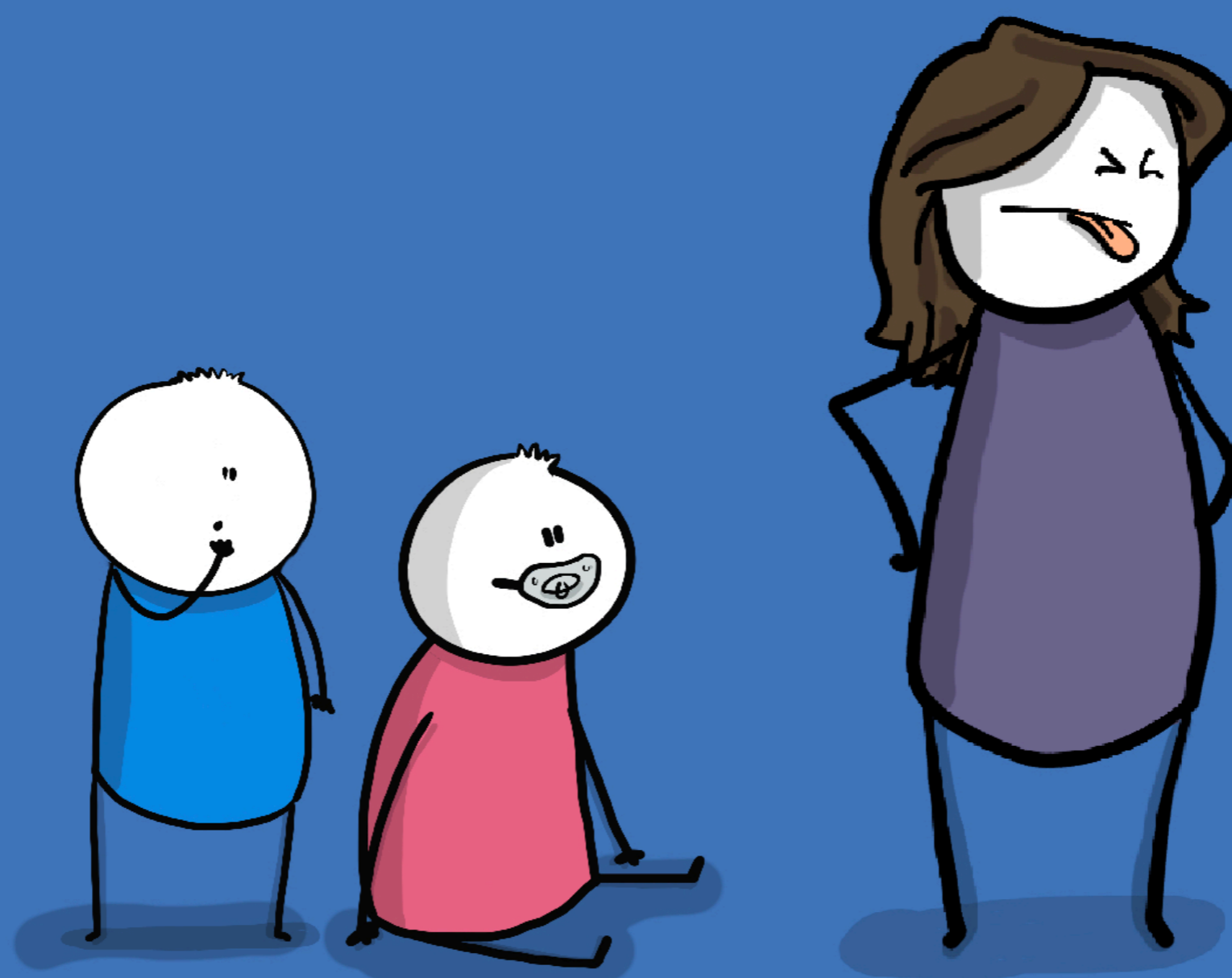

Don't mother your Scrum Teams

Whenever we want to interact with one of the Scrum Teams, it shouldn't have to go through you. It's not your job to be their gatekeeper. Get your Scrum Team to a place where they can stand on their own feet without you constantly holding their own hands.

If you always treat your Scrum Team as children, they will always need parental guidance. Let them make mistakes and learn from them.

Escape the comfort of a Team

Many Scrum Masters love staying in the safety and comfort of the Scrum Team. The biggest impediments to agility usually are not on the team-level, but the organisational level.

We understand it's difficult to let your team go, but at some point they shouldn't need you as much and that's fine. Help your Scrum Team to spread their wings, so you can spread yours too.
